




















The children made their own Easter ducks, cards, wreaths and they loved playing different games!

March was our busiest month so far this year, with 15 referrals prepared during that period.

West Cumberland Hospital Maternity Toiletry Bag Appeal

In June we were able to present the Maternity Department of West Cumberland Hospital with 20 toiletry bags that our project had prepared from generous donations from the public. The appeal was the results of discussions with maternity staff that we work with regularly whilst preparing our usual referrals for the community. We were happy to coordinate this appeal which supported women who might be attending the unit unplanned or who were in need of some support.

St Mary's RC Primary School Donation

This term we had the wonderful pleasure of attending a special Celebration Assembly at St Mary's RC Primary School in Harrington and meeting a very kind pupil called Molly again. She presented our project with a very generous donation of £143 which she had raised entirely on her own through making more bracelets, just like she had earlier this year! We have never received this kind of support from one school, never mind the same individual, and so were very grateful. We were able to purchase baby wipes, baby lotion, cellular blankets, toothpaste and toothbrushes for local children, baby socks, nappy cream, baby brush & comb sets and Milton sterilising tablets.

More space

We are very grateful for the extra space that we have been given at Birks Road. Thank you! It is enabling us to keep all our resources in one place and store a larger number of large items such as pushchairs and cots, which helps us to react more quickly to requests for help.

Howgill Nursery @ Kells


Here at Kells, the children have been looking after real life caterpillars! They have been taking care of them and watch them grow into beautiful butterflies before letting them free.

The new way to pay fees at our nurseries

ParentZone

ParentZone app is where you can access snapshots of your child's 'wow' moments including pictures, videos and links to Early Years frameworks and guidance. You can upload your own observations from your time outside of nursery, which will give you a more complete view of your child's learning experiences. Staff can use the information to inform planning and next steps and strengthen bonds with the family.

ParentZone also comes with it's own dedicated parent Hub; this is full of helpful resources, information and activity ideas, ParentHub helps further improve child development by encouraging a continuation of learning at home.

Enjoy the quickest way to make a payment to your childcare fees, with around the clock access. With in-app payments, you have the convenience of being able to pay fees, by card. You can also access finances through the ParentZone app so you know exactly what you owe. Your payments are then automatically reconciled against the bill.



Paying through ParentZone is quick, easy and you will see your payment on your account immediately.

No need to wait for payments to be allocated to your invoices. Immediate allocation in real time!

We require payments in advance for bookings.
